Tic Ltd., which is based in Turkey and is responsible for sourcing materials, manufacturing, and distribution.

Due Diligence Processes

Compass Point Interiors Ltd. engages with suppliers to understand their practices and implements corrective actions where necessary. We conduct due diligence on our suppliers and partners to identify and mitigate risks of modern slavery. This includes:

- Supplier audits
- Risk assessments of new suppliers
- Regular reviews of existing suppliers


Reporting and Accountability
